

General Questions:

1. Demographic info on the residents, taxpayers and/or families living within the Battle Ground School District. Preferably this would include items such as: Single/Two parent homes; income stratification; Age data; Religious affiliation; etc. We're looking to see what you (the BGSD) is using to determine the demographics of residents of the district so please share any all relative information. We would like to understand what demographic data you have and use for decision making. Please share what you have and use. [Answered in April 19, 2021 response.](#)
2. What data do you have relating to the students (in numbers and demographic data) that state specific self designations (such as but not limited to): lgbtq; religion, ethnic and any other designations the district has/does ask about and/or for. We are looking to understand all demographic data you have for the student population. [We do not keep, or ask for, this kind of data on our students. Our district has not participated in these questions on the Healthy Youth Survey, either, so we don't have this information.](#)
3. Please supply any data on bullying (harassment or other terms you substitute), over the past decade broken out by year. We're looking to understand the number of cases and trends. Are there any specifics to the bullying reports and if so what are those? We're seeking to understand the scope, types, numbers, reasons for and trend over the past decade. WE are not asking for names. If this can be assembled for the district as a whole and by school that would be helpful. [Please see attached excel spreadsheet. The codes for Federal race are: 1= American Indian or Alaskan Native; 2=Asian, 3=Black or African American, 4=Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander, 5=White.](#)
4. Opt-Out: Sex Ed/CSE or other programs - What is the process for Optioning out of SexEd/CSE or any other program? [Parents are notified of the teaching of HIV/AIDS and Human Growth and Development at least 30 days prior to the teaching of the content. Parents are able to review the content online. If they do not want their child\(ren\) to participate in the teaching of the content they may fill out the online form and submit it. Teachers look at the form and determine which students need alternate classroom assignments while others are learning about HIV/AIDS or Human Growth and Development. This year our Comprehensive Sexual Health Education \(high school only\) was an opt-in process. Last year we did not teach any sexual health content so there was no opt-out process for that. 2018-19 was the first year we collected district-wide data on the sexual education opt-out process.](#) How many students have been opted out by year for each of the past 5 years in each of the categories you define and track?
