

Q1: What is your position on Critical Race Theory being required training for teachers and potentially being taught in schools?

*My position is that it should not be required training for teachers nor does it have any place in schools.*

Q2: What is your position/views on Comprehensive Sex Education (CSE) being mandated by the Legislature and the State Superintendent of Schools?

*I don't believe that it should be mandated. After serving on the Battle Ground Middle School Sexual Health Advisory Committee for 10 weeks, I'm very familiar with the curriculum and I don't believe they have any business mandating this material in schools.*

Q3: What is your position/view on mandated vaccination for Covid 19 (or similar situations in the future)? i.e what if there is a requirement for proof of vaccination for students to return to school?

*Whether or not to vaccinate a child is a private decision to be made between the parent and the child's doctor. I believe the Covid-19 vaccine needs to be eligible for exemptions, just like all the other vaccines on the WA state Children's Immunization schedule set out by the Washington State Department of Health. It shouldn't even be a part of the discussion while it is only authorized for emergency use by the FDA.*

Q4: What is your position on the continued requirement for masks by students while in school?

*Children were designed to breathe freely, without hindrance. Typical social interactions during these formative years of social and emotional development are critical. Masking is clearly not typical. Also, in most cases the box plainly says, "Will not provide any protection against COVID-19 (coronavirus)".*

Q5: What is your position/view on "equity, equality and inclusion" in public schools?

*The school system has the responsibility of teaching each student based on their unique gifts, abilities, and needs. Each student deserves equal opportunity and care to be educated in a safe environment.*

Q6: What is your position/views on Common Core?

*Common Core is a "one size fits all" attempt and it did not prove to be as successful as hoped.*

Q7: What is your position/views on Social Emotional Learning?

*It depends who's asking and what their definition of SEL is. Emotional health is critical for all students and we should provide them with a safe learning environment (on their own and in groups) at school. My understanding is that SEL causes schools to focus less on academic content and knowledge and more on student's mindsets, behaviors, emotional distractions, stress, values, and morals in place of academic achievements.*

Q8: What are the top 3 challenges you would address in your first elected year and why?

- 1. Restoring trust between the community and the district. Trust has been broken and I think that is a huge problem that needs to be addressed and resolved.*
- 2. Political agendas are being pushed in our classrooms. I have big problems with that. Children need to be taught **how** to think, not **what** to think. Classrooms should be non-partisan. We need to get back to educating and stay far away from indoctrinating.*
- 3. Potential discrimination of students whose parents determine that it's not best for them to be vaccinated.*

Q9: If Washington State proposed legislation that would provide health care to children in school and at age 13 parental notification and approval were not required for treatment, what would be your position and view?

*The parent/guardian always needs to be a part of a minor's medical decisions. A parent knows their children better than anyone else. This is not the school system's responsibility nor is it their place.*

Q10: What is your view on the role of CTE (Career Training Education)? Is it sufficient, under or over utilized?

*It's an excellent training ground for our kids who are not planning on going to college. Skills training is always beneficial for students and I think we've recognized the value of it in Battle Ground, however there is always room for more growth.*
